

Environmental policy

6. New business

When new operations are put in motion, there is a tradeoff what the possible implications might be for the environment. These tradeoffs are included in the decision making process for new business.

7. Information

Up-to-date information concerning environmental issues is gathered by all means. This is to keep abreast of the latest developments and to adapt to these developments. Good communication with local and international authorities in the field of legislation is important.
